Subject: Disciplinary warning for unsportsmanlike conduct

Dear Sir,

Sportsmanlike behaviour during FITEQ competitions is of paramount importance for the sport of teqball.

FITEQ members are fully bound by this principle under the current FITEQ Statutes and the discipline clause of the Player Participation Terms & Conditions executed in view of a FITEQ official competition:

„A Player shall always abide by the Competition Rules, related instructions by competition officials, Organizer and/or the organizers, and behave in a sportsmanlike manner. Any cheating, substance use or unsportsmanlike behaviour may – at the discretion of Competition officials – lead to their and/or their Team’s ejection from the Competition, loss of their ranking and/or forfeiture of any Prizes won.”

Offensive behaviour by your side was officially reported towards the referees officiating at the singles final event of the Polish Challenger Series – Round 1 held on 25 October 2020 in Kobylka, Poland.

In particular, there were several officially reported disrespectful incidents committed by you towards the opponent athlete (link to relevant videos available upon request).

In light of the above, FITEQ hereby issues this official disciplinary warning. Kindly desist from committing similar actions in the future while participating into FITEQ competitions.

This case may serve as an aggravating circumstance during any subsequent disciplinary proceeding commenced in the future.
