As far as the <u>top breeds</u> go in each city, New Yorkers have an affinity for the classic <u>German Shepherd</u> (which also won this year's Best in Show Award at the Westminster Kennel Club Dog Show), while Los Angelenos favor the most popular breed in the country, the <u>Labrador Retriever</u>. San Francisco, Miami and Denver residents share a preference for the allergy-friendly cross-breed <u>Goldendoodle</u>, while those in the Pacific Northwest in Seattle desire the <u>Siberian Husky</u>.

"While people across the country may differ in their view on many topics, puppy love is not one of them.
