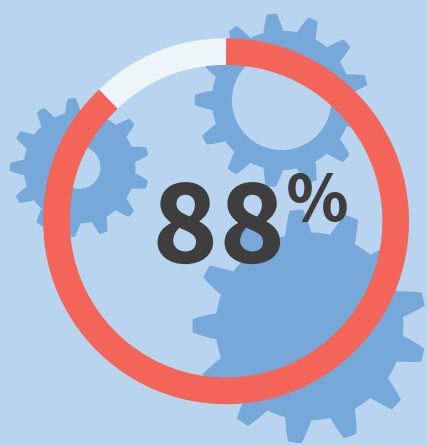
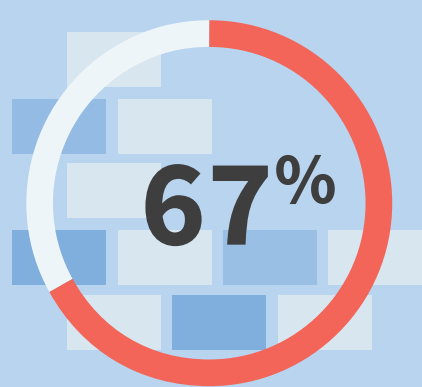

of dev teams use agile.



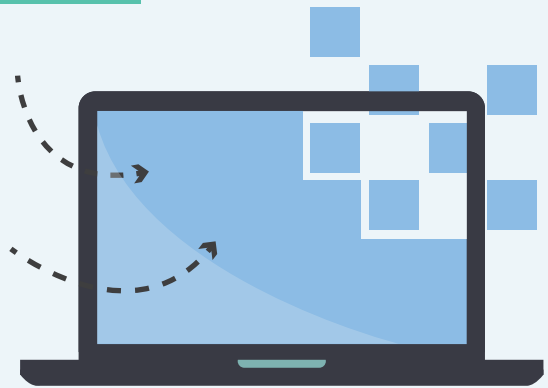
deploy new builds on a weekly basis – at least.

Great for ongoing projects.

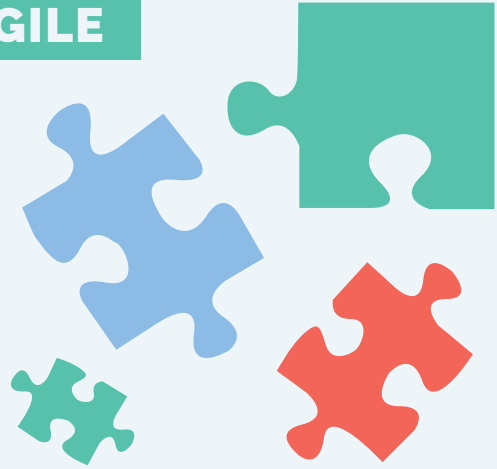

Helps teams get right down to business on straightforward projects.

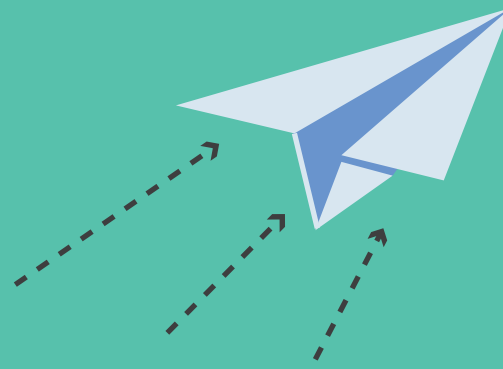
## AGILE
