Apple on Twitter (NLP)

- Built an NLP using 9 topics for modeling using CountVectorizer and Non-Negative Matrix Factorization (NMF).
- NLTK Vader to get sentiment test and K-Means using TSNE using K=2.

Predicting Chicago Food Establishment Inspections (Classification)

- A dataset of over 200K food inspections were used to predict which establishment to target and make more efficient the process.
- Built a classification model using Pandas, Numpy, KNN, Random Forest, and XGBoost - XGBClassifier.

Airline overbooking model (Business)

- Using data from the Department of Transportation to find that the number of people bumped from flights is in the minimum in the last 3 decades.
- The model was built using the probability of no-show and a Binomial Function on Python.

Movie Suggestion for Movie Studio (Linear Regression)

- Over 20 years of movies scrapped using BeautifulSoup from Box Office Mojo, resulting with 2000 movies.
- Pandas, DaTime, Numpy were used to do the linear regression modeling: Ordinary Least Squares (OLS), Ridge CV, LASSO CV. For plotting Matplotlib, Seaborn, and StatsModels

MTA subway demand during COVID-19 (EDA)

- Analyzed the NYC subway turnstile 2019 - 2021 data that contains over 2 billion.
- Pandas, StatsModels, and Numpy for data manipulation, Matplotlib and Seaborn also were used for plotting.
