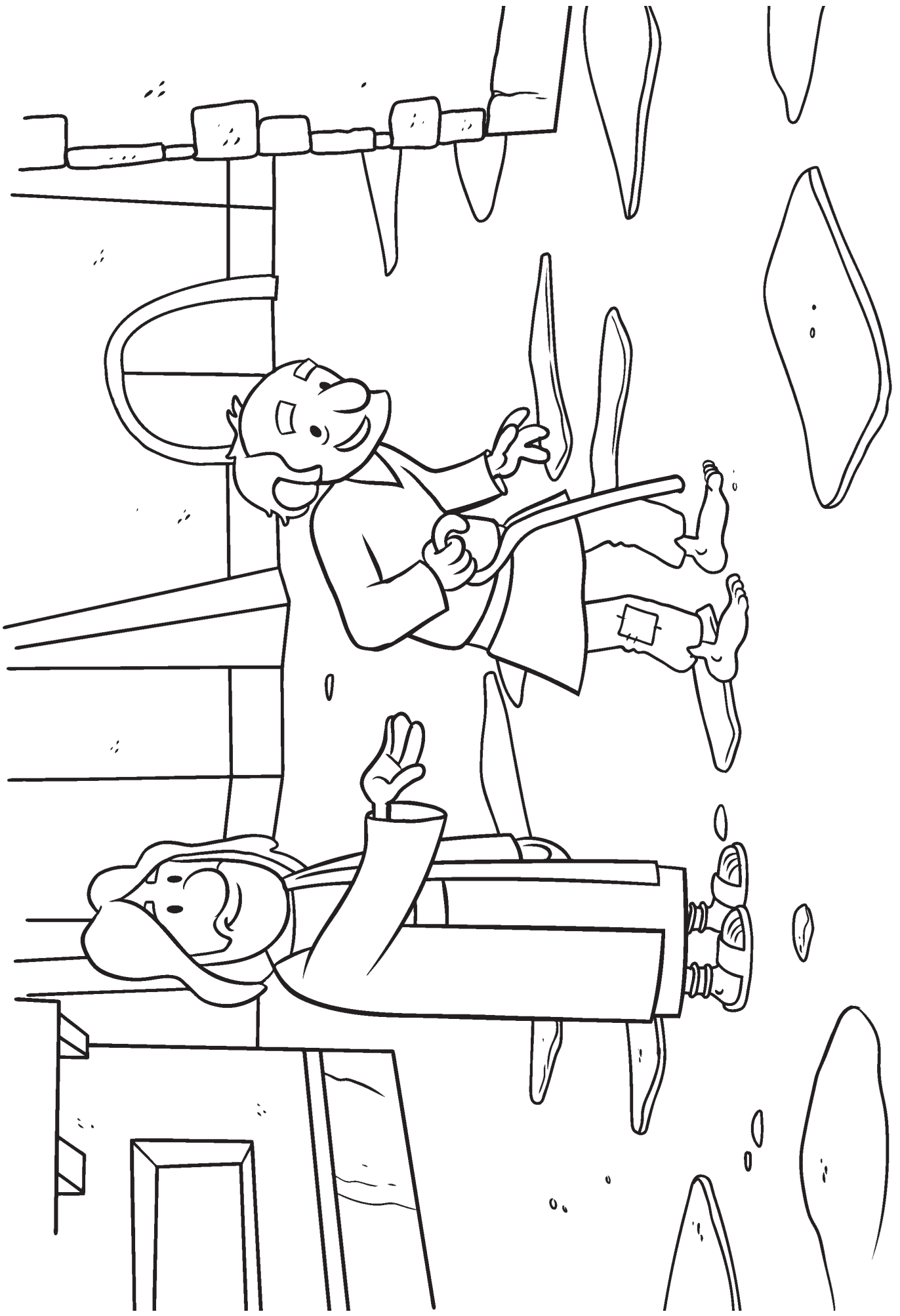
Jesus traveled and taught people. His most famous sermon is called the Sermon on the Mount. (Matthew 5-7)

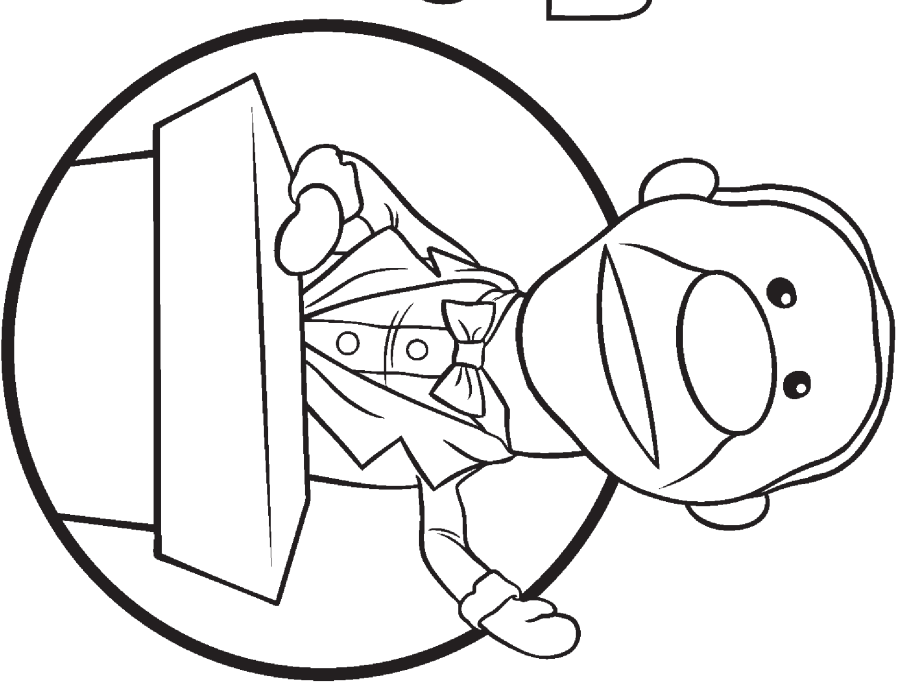

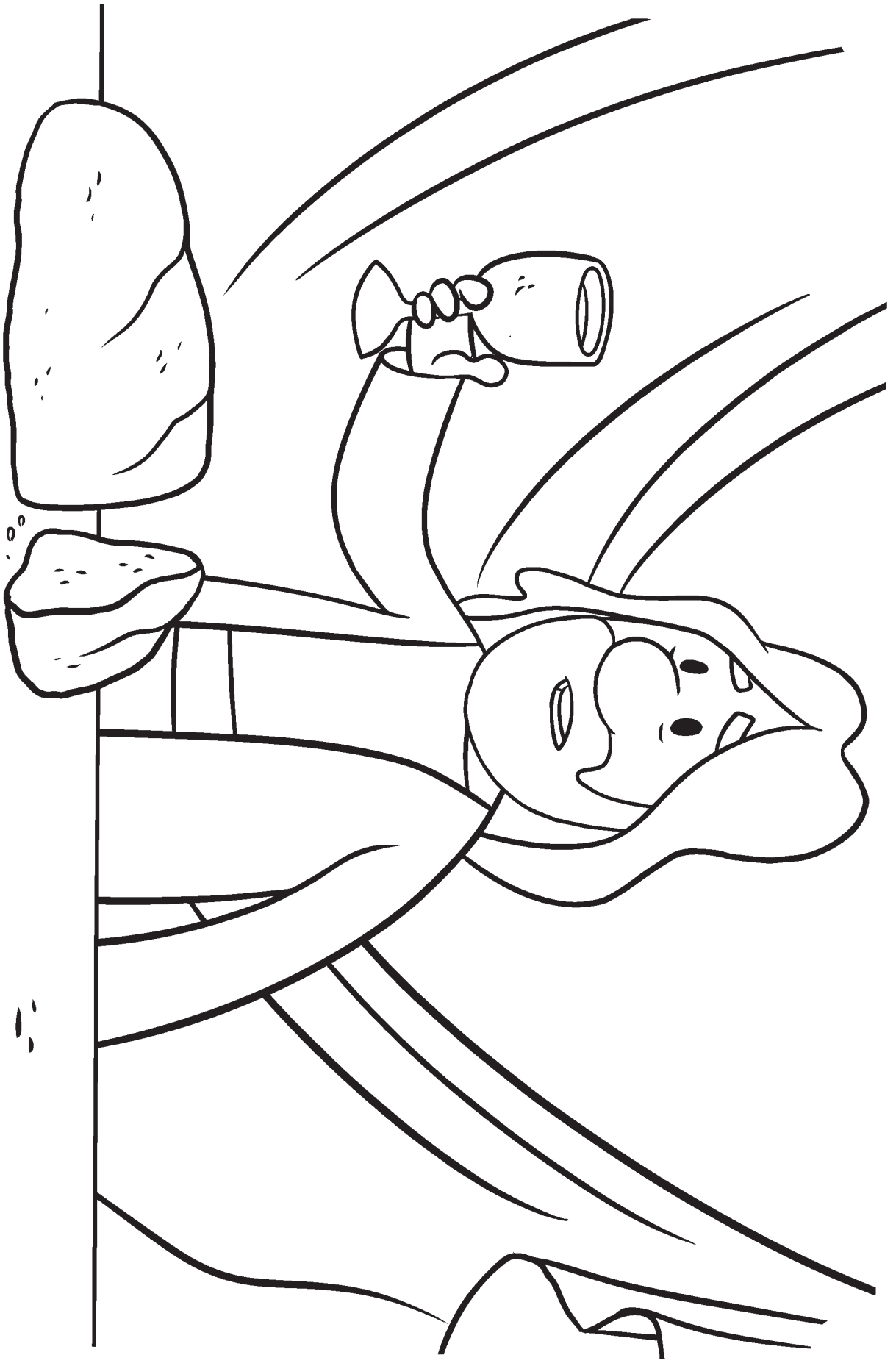

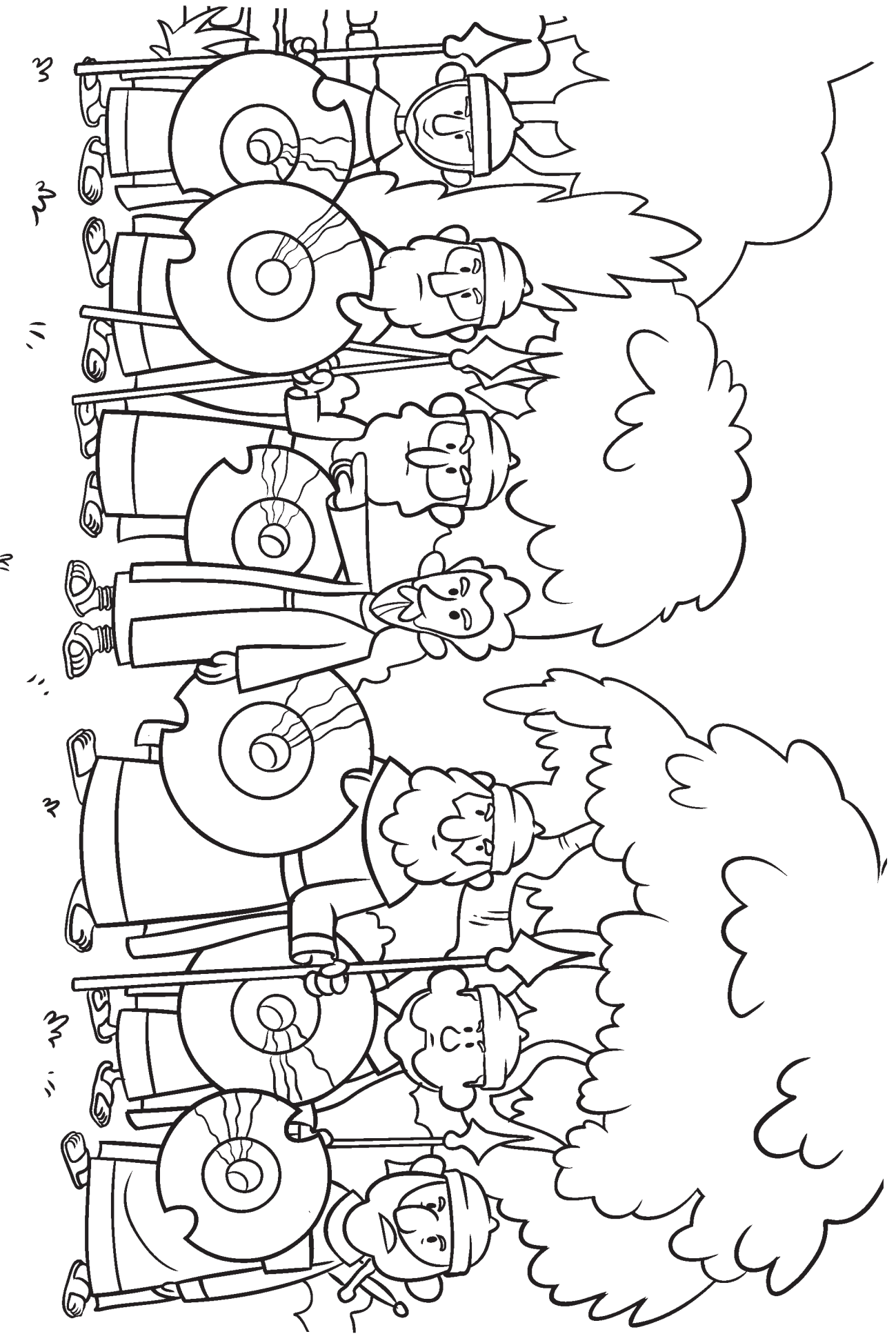
Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey and people cried, "Hosanna!" while waving palm branches. (John 12:12-15)



Jesus hosted a Passover meal for His disciples before He died. He told them that His body would be broken and His blood would be shed for them. (Luke 22:14-23)



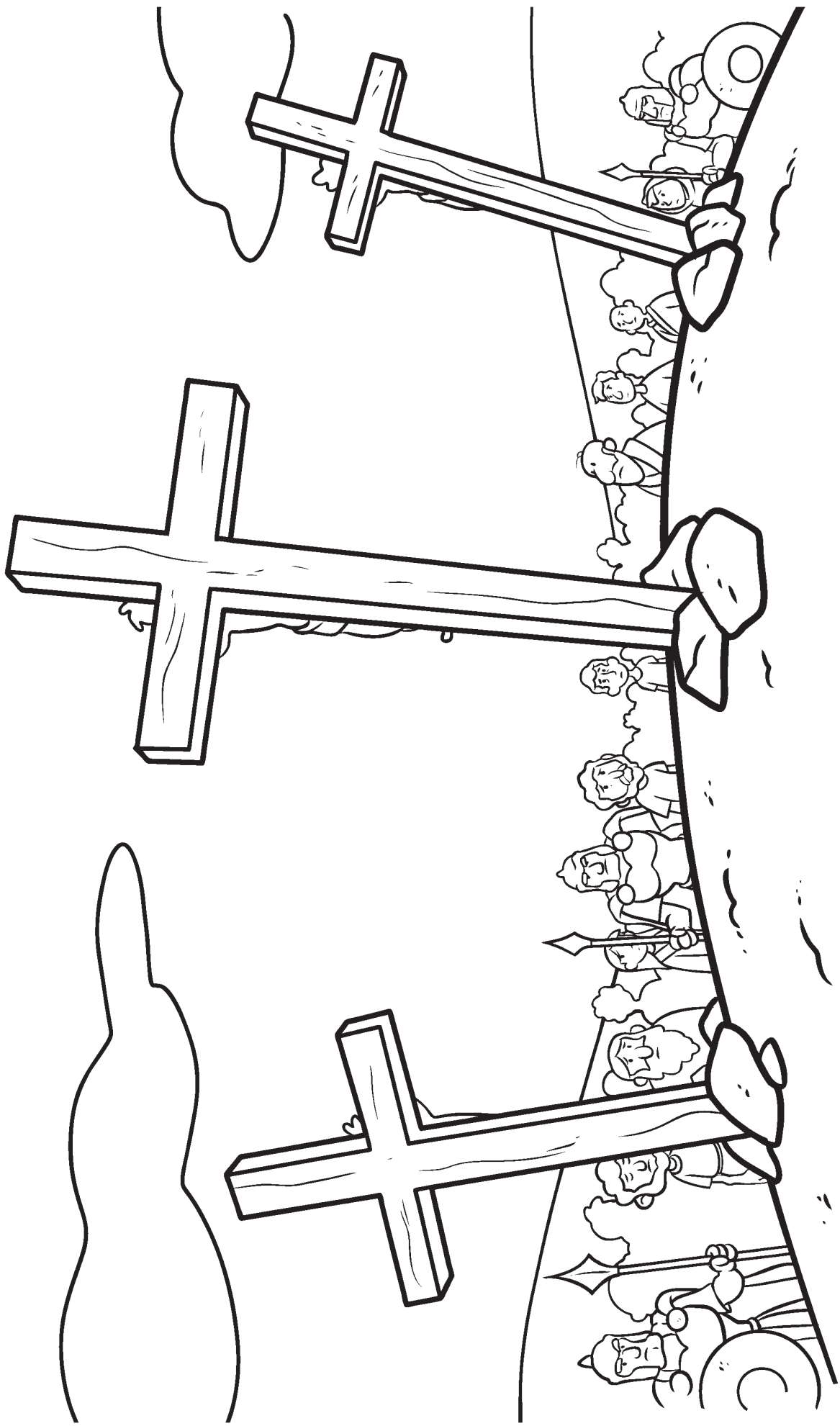
Jesus prayed in a garden when He knew that He was about to die. He trusted God. (Luke 22:39-44)

Jesus was put on trial and was sentenced to die. (Mark 14:43-50)

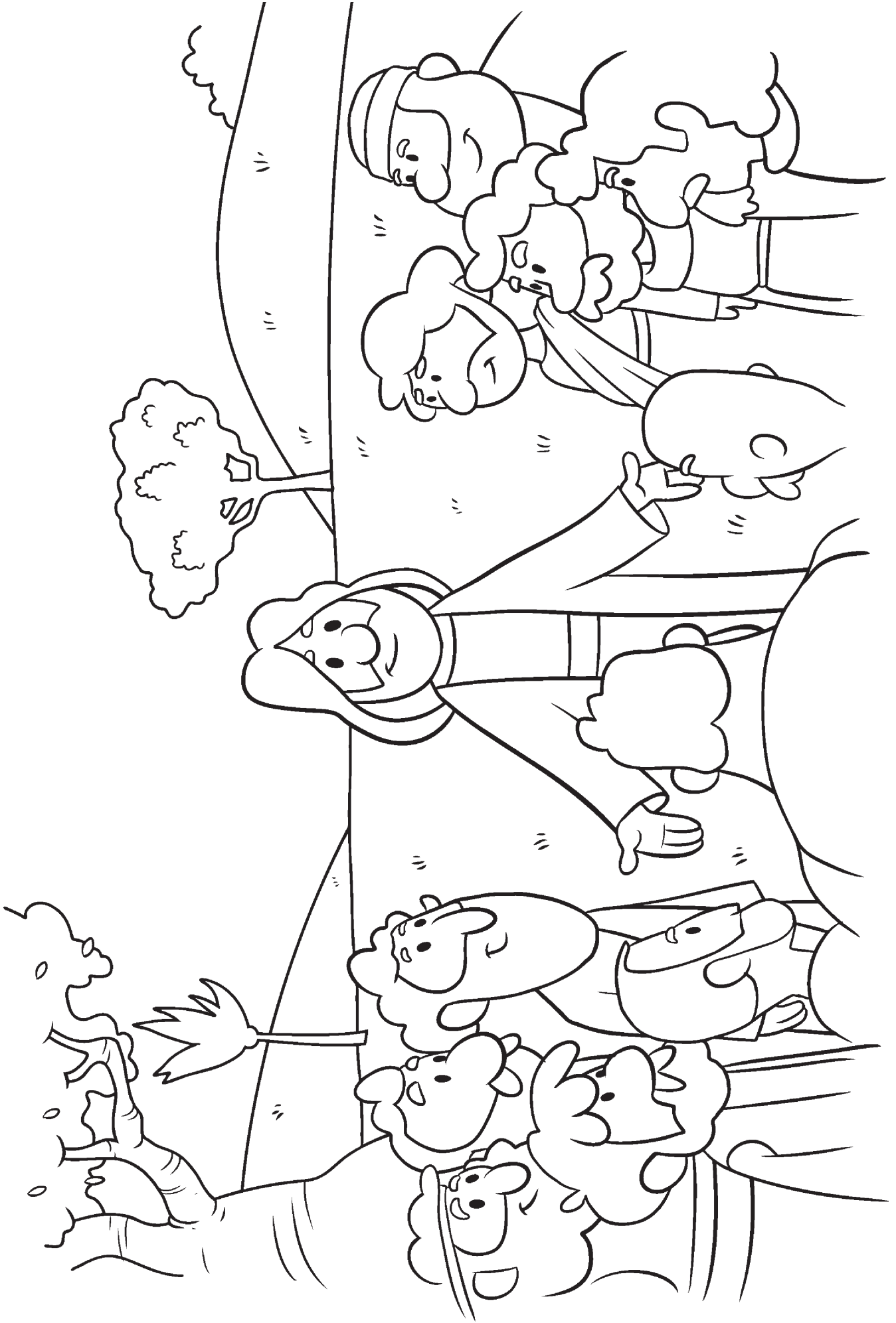




Jesus died to save the world that was cursed by sin. He took the punishment for sin so that all who trust Him could be part of the Kingdom of God. (Mark 15:33-39)

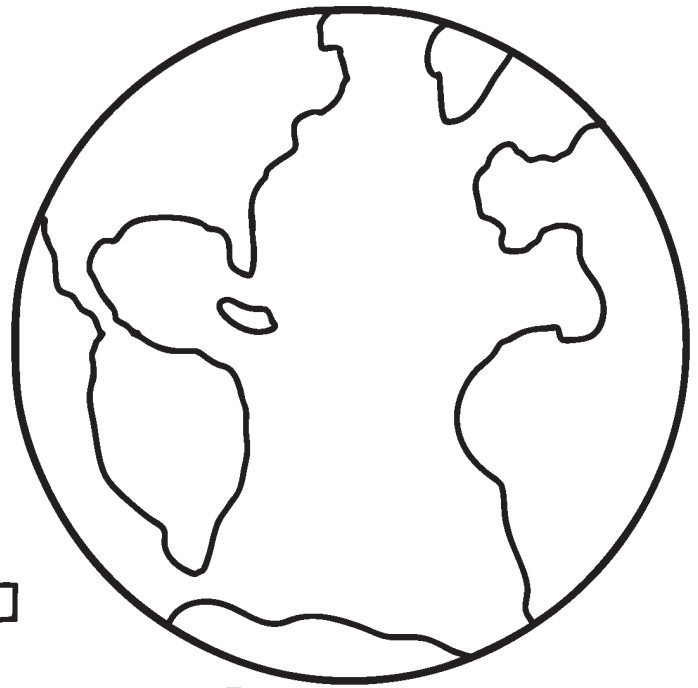


Jesus had been dead for three days when two women went to visit His tomb and found it empty. Jesus was risen! He had defeated death! (Mark 16:1-7)
