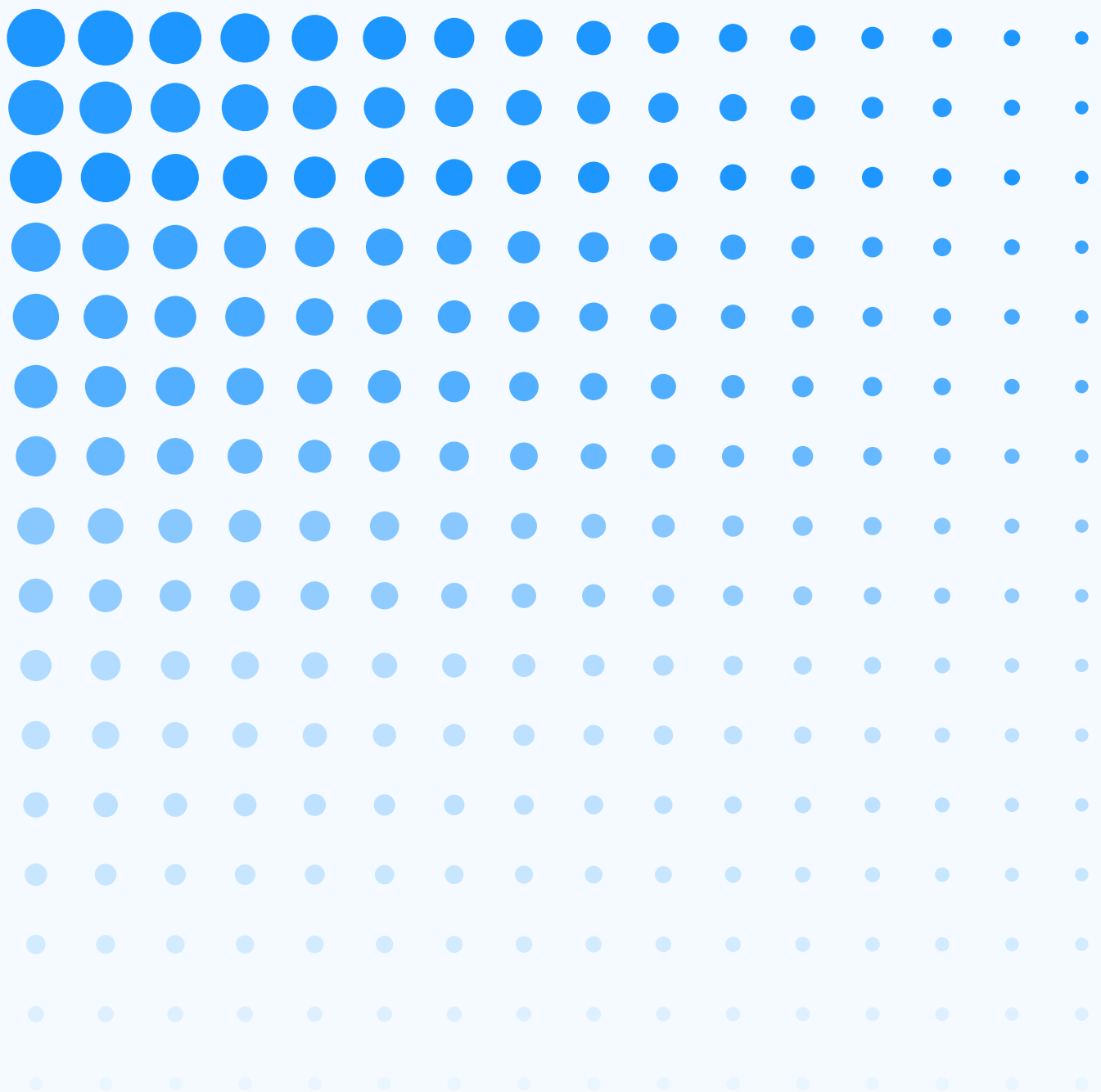
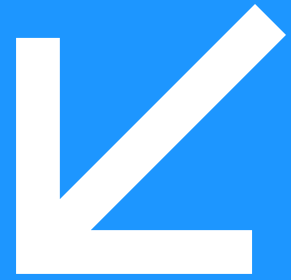


# How Data Pipelines Help Data Science Teams

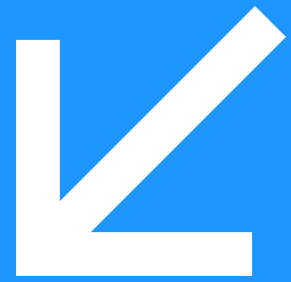

## INTRODUCTION

### **Data pipelines are a crucial aspect of data science.**

They help to automate the process of collecting, storing and analyzing data. Data pipelines can connect disparate systems or databases, aggregate data from different sources, transform raw insights into valuable information, etc. This article will discuss how data pipeline solutions can work with your team to make their lives easier and improve the quality of results.

## ESSENTIAL PARTS OF AN ELT DATA PIPELINE

**First of all, let's discuss what a data pipeline is. A data pipeline typically connects multiple disparate systems and databases to create an automated workflow that can be executed from beginning to end without human intervention.**

There are many different types of pipelines that range in complexity depending on their use case or purpose. For example, there may be a separate pipeline for each application and one giant "enterprise"-style ELT (extract-transform-load) type solution where the entire organization shares insights across teams and departments.

ELT stands for extract-transform-load, which refers to how most enterprise-level pipelines work - starting with extracting raw or unprocessed information from external sources, transforming it into valuable metrics and visualizations and then loading it into a separate system for reporting and analysis.



To assist with automating many different tasks, ETL tools typically split workflows into four stages:

## 1 COLLECTION

Where raw information is pulled from source systems or databases by crawlers or APIs

## 2 TRANSFORMATION

Where data is combined, manipulated or restructured to make it more useful for reporting/analysis. This could mean importing raw CSV files into an SQL database that has been pre-configured with custom metadata fields and schemas, creating precise reports tailored to individuals' needs, etc. The possibilities here are endless depending on the use case of your organization.

## 3 LOADING

Where transformed information can be made available in a separate system, so teams have access to it without manually rerunning every single step of the pipeline.

## 3 STORAGE

where that information is stored so it can be accessed later for processing/analysis etc. This could mean storing files locally, uploading them to cloud storage services like [AWS SNS](#), putting them inside NoSQL datastores such as MongoDB, using [Hadoop](#) distributed filesystems like HDFS, or even relational database management systems like MySQL.

## WHAT ARE THE TOP BENEFITS OF USING A DATA PIPELINE TOOL?

### Using a data pipeline solution has many benefits for the entire organization.

## HOW DO THESE TEAM MEMBERS INTERACT WITH EACH OTHER?

**Data science teams are comprised of people from different backgrounds and disciplines that have a common goal of extracting insights from data.**

A typical team will include:

### 1 DATA SCIENTIST

[Data scientists](#) are analysts by trade, but they also have some coding knowledge, so they can use data mining tools to explore raw datasets and pull out meaningful insights. They'll typically work closely with product managers or other business stakeholders to understand what questions need answering before writing code that extracts the relevant information from their dataset(s) of choice.

### 2 DATA ANALYST

After understanding all the different things you want to learn about your customers (or whatever topic applies in your industry), an analyst will design a set of experiments that help them achieve this goal. This might involve using statistical analysis techniques like [regression modeling](#) for econometric analyses or creating A/B tests for multivariate studies. Their end goal is to produce a report outlining key findings and answering any questions business stakeholders might have.

### 3 DATA ARCHITECT

A data architect is responsible for [designing the infrastructure](#) that underpins your company's data processing pipeline. This can include designing databases, creating ETL processes using tools like Integrate.io to transform raw datasets into different forms, and setting up any machine learning models/algorithms.

Backend developers - These are the people who build new components that help improve your data pipeline. They'll also work closely with the data architect/analyst mentioned above when creating reports that involve transforming raw information into something more presentable, like visualization dashboards or charts.

### 4 DATA ENGINEERS

Machine learning engineer - If you're building pipelines that involve predictive analytics models (e.g., machine learning algorithms like random forests, neural networks, etc.), then there'll be a need for somebody to manage this process and make sure it runs smoothly.

### 5 SOFTWARE ENGINEERS

These are the people who write code that powers any tools used within your data pipeline (e.g., ETL/ELT software). They should also have some experience in writing backend systems or components to work with developers on automating routine tasks related to moving datasets around inside large organizations.



## 6 DOMAIN EXPERT

If you're working within an industry with a lot of technical jargon (e.g., medicine, biology, etc.), it's likely that the analysts/data scientists will need to work closely with domain experts. They can guide them on how best to approach projects involving analytics and machine learning and any other questions they might have about your data.

## 7 DATA VISUALIZATION SPECIALIST

You'll often find yourself wanting to communicate insights discovered from datasets in creative ways using diagrams or infographics since this helps [break down complex information](#) into something more digestible for non-technical audiences. If this is the case, hiring a visual designer should be considered, so reports produced by your team are packed full of exciting infographics or visuals rather than being filled only with statistics and plain text.

## 8 BUSINESS ANALYST

You should also consider hiring somebody with a business mindset. This will mean there's somebody else on your team who understands why projects are being carried out, as well as any questions business stakeholders might have about them.

## WHAT TOOLS DO DATA SCIENCE TEAMS NEED?

**Data science teams need a wide range of tools to carry out their work successfully.**
